

# Mount Isa Athletics

The record season of the Mount Isa Athletics Club will be celebrated this Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> November when they conduct their annual Break-up & Presentation Day.

A virtual truck load of Medals, Trophies and Certificates will be presented at the event which is the culmination of the 2013 season. All registered athletes who competed throughout the year will receive a Personal Best certificate highlighting their best performances of the season.

An unprecedented 69 Gold, Silver and Bronze PB medals are to be awarded to athletes that have passed the pre-determined levels needed. Many of the recipients of the Points Champion trophies had not been finalized until the final events of the season with quite a few age groups being separated by only one or two points by seasons end.

100% Attendance trophies will be presented to nearly 10% of the club with a record 17 athletes accomplishing the feat. 2013 has been the best attended season thus far with 76 of the 182 athletes having 75% attendance or better. This was clearly evident with the average turnout for club days being 124 for over the entire sixteen week season.

Trophy selectors had a hard time deciding the recipients for the seven major trophy categories as so many athletes have excelled throughout the season. 10 trophies are up for grabs in the majors being – Most Outstanding Performance, Best & Fairest, Ambassador Award and Volunteer of the year along with male and female trophies for the Runner, Jumper and Thrower of the year.

Other awards to be presented on the day will go to the Club Champions and Runner ups, Club Record Breakers and there will be a bunch of Coaches Awards also handed out. All athletes in the Tiny Tot age group will receive a Participation trophy for their efforts throughout the year.

The Breakup and Presentation will commence at 2.00pm at Good Shepherd Catholic College's new Activities Hall. The club has organized a Jumping Castle to be on location to keep the kids entertained until presentations start. A light afternoon tea and sweets will also be provided for attendees. All going to plan the day should conclude around 6.00pm.
