The Mount Isa Athletics Club had another extraordinary day of results from their most recent Club day at Sunset Oval. The athletes upped the ante from the previous week this time finishing the day with five perfect 5 from 5 personal bests, coupled with 19 Legend Certificates, 8 more Club Records and 4 more Development Squad qualifiers.

Teaghan Goodger seems to be up to her old tricks from last season again posting perfect 5 from 5's in consecutive weeks. Joining Teaghan with perfect scores were Abigail Hogan, Kai Fraser, Courtney Boshoff and Patrick Baker. The entire 119 attending athletes averaged just under 2 PB's a piece. A further ten athletes, Kisha Simpson, Tarell Rea, Miesha Nelson, Tia Peel, Tiarna Krutzfeldt, Mitchell Hujanen, Jackson Constantinou, Michael Bracs, Phoenix McMillan and Rico Waerea, pulled up just one short recording four well earned PB's each.

There doesn't seem to be much let up in the pummelling that the Club Records have been taking this season. "Lightning" Perkins (Denzil) had a truly astonishing result in the 10 year boys 100m posting a record time of 13.8s. The time has now taken eight tenths of a second from the old record which has stood since 1997. To reinforce the calibre of the result the time is 0.5s quicker than the 11 year olds record and only 0.1s slower than the record time for the 12 year olds. New Hammer throwers Breanna Waerea and Patrick Baker both put big increases on their newly acquired Hammer records. 12 year old Cannon's (Breanna) 21.15m throw smashed her old record by 4m and was even good enough to surpass the U16 Womens Development Squad qualifying level. Patrick also added over two metres to his previous best throwing 23.94m.

Other records to take a fall were U20 Womens Javelin to Brianna Smith, 40-44 year Womens Discus to Tanya Hales, Mens 30-34 year Hurdles to Stephen Zoch and 40-44 year Mens Hurdles to David Scott and the F38 Javelin to Para-athlete Daniel Wing.

Legend Certificates will again be aplenty with a further 19 to be presented to Rico Waerea, Tremaine Body, Michelle Bracs, Tarell Rae, Lachlan McCoy, Illy Chapman, Kai Fraser, Erin Faithful, Ally Haddon, Courtney Boshoff, Luke Hales, Charleey-K Edwards, Teaghan Goodger and Mitchell Hujanen.

Mitchell Hujanen's 32.08m Hammer throw elevated his silver Development Squad qualifier to Gold level. Teaghan Goodger achieved her first qualifier for the season with a 20.54 effort in Hammer throw. Courtney Boshoff added Javelin to her list of qualifiers for the squad.
